ARRIVING IN LONDON

TRAVELLING TO LABAN FROM WATERLOO STATION (EUROSTAR)

London Underground

You can use the London Underground to travel into central London. If you think that you will do more than one train journey in a day or use more than one mode of transport (bus/tube/train/DLR) you will probably find that buying a travel card will work out cheaper for you. Travel cards offer unlimited travel within specified zones in London.

Travel cards are sold at either peak or off-peak prices depending on the time that you are travelling.

A 1-Day travel card for zones 1-2 only costs £6.00 if sold for peak time and £4.70 for off-peak times.

A 3-Day travel card for zones 1-2 costs £15.00 for peak time

A season ticket/ 7 Day travel card for zones 1-2 costs £21.40

FROM WATERLOO STATION (EUROSTAR)

Average journey time: 30 min

Take the **Jubilee Line** towards Stratford

Change at **Canary Wharf**

Take the **Docklands Light Railway** (DLR) towards Lewisham

Stop at **Cutty Sark**

At Cutty Sark turn right out of the station and right again on to Creek Road.

Take the second left after the bridge, Creekside and LABAN is on your left (10 min walk), or continue a bit further on Creek Road for McMillan Student/Summer Village.
